VEKLURY[®] (remdesivir) 100 mg for injection, lyophilized powder

Dosage form and strength¹

100 mg, available as a sterile, preservative-free, white to off-white to yellow lyophilized powder in single-dose vial for reconstitution

How supplied¹

Supplied as a single-dose vial containing a sterile, preservative-free, white to off-white to yellow lyophilized powder. It requires reconstitution and further dilution prior to administration by intravenous infusion.

Discard unused portion.

The container closure is not made with natural rubber latex.

Storage and handling¹

Store VEKLURY for injection, 100 mg vials below 30 °C (below 86 °F) until required for use. After reconstitution, use vials immediately to prepare diluted solution. Dilute the reconstituted solution in 0.9% sodium chloride injection, USP within the same day as administration.

The diluted VEKLURY solution in the infusion bags can be stored up to 24 hours at room temperature (20 to 25 °C [68 to 77 °F]) prior to administration or 48 hours at refrigerated temperature (2 to 8 °C [36 to 46 °F]).
